

## Sunday School Week 4

Chronological order: Letters/epistles, Gospels, Revelation

More historical evidence, more actual fragments closest to actual occurrences than any historical document

### **Galatians 4:4 | the fullness of time God sent forth His Son.**

Rome ruled most of the known world, roads to everywhere, common language and culture, Caesar was the “the son of god”, the way Rome took over new cities would be the way that God would set up His Kingdom

Jesus came to “fulfill the law and the prophets not to abolish them” Mat 15:17-20: Four types of laws, civil, dietary, priestly, moral. Jesus expanded the moral laws.

Moses told of another prophet like Moses that would come. Deut 18:15,19, Acts 3:22-23; Both were called out of Egypt, baptism/Red Sea, 40 days/40 years in the wilderness, sermon on the mount/ laws of Mount Sinai, crucifixion/ Passover lamb, everlasting redemption and restoration with God in new Jerusalem/ temporary redemption and restoration in the land of milk and honey.

Acts, the spreading of the good news!

Jesus appears to many then ascends to heaven

Pentecost return of Shekinah Glory!

Followers of the way share freely, Ananias and Sofira?

Persecution by devout Jews, Saul is one of them.

Saul on the road to Damascus, renamed Paul, preach to the gentiles

Peter and Cornelius, first Gentile Christian

Devout Jews upset with Paul preaching to gentiles

Council of Jerusalem, abstain from meat sacrificed to idols, sexual immorality, strangled animals and blood

Devout Jews seek to kill Paul, Paul seeks audience with Caesar, goes to Rome

Apostles are murdered or die

John writes Revelation. The Final Act! Only book with a blessing and a curse Rev 22:18-19
