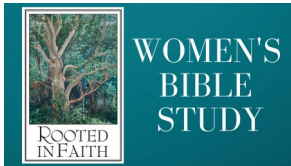
For those worshipping virtually, you will access the worship service on the home page, the same way you do now. If watching later, a recording of the service will be available online.
