

Healthy Classroom Policies, 2022-2023

- 1. All rooms are cleaned and disinfected after each use.
- 2. No sick children, parents, or workers are allowed in the classrooms. Health questions (below) are listed outside each classroom and individuals need to answer no to all questions to enter the rooms.
- 3. If enough healthy teachers are not available for the classroom, the classroom will be closed. A notice will be placed on the classroom door.

Healthy classroom questions:

Do you, your child, or anyone else in your household exhibit any of the following symptoms? If yes, your child may not attend class today.

- Does your child have a:
 - o Fever over 100.4° F (or on fever-reducing medication)
 - New uncontrolled cough (not due to allergies)
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - o Chills or muscle pain
 - Sore throat
 - o Diarrhea, vomiting, nausea, abdominal pain
 - o Green or yellow mucous discharge
- Is anyone in your household currently being quarantined for COVID-19?

If you or your child have been exposed to anyone in the last 10 days who has tested positive for COVID-19 you must be masked to attend class.
